CUPCAKE LINER TREE GARLAND

Materials Needed:

- Glue
- Ribbon
- Cupcake liners
- Sequins
- Optional: Hole punch

Instructions:

Fold cupcake liners in half and then in half again to form a triangle. Use three cupcake liner triangles to create a tree shape, inserting the top of the second triangle halfway into the first triangle, and the third triangle halfway into the second triangle and then securing with glue.

Decorate the three layers of your tree with sequins or accent decorations. Glue the trees to ribbon to form a garland.

Helpful Hint: You can also hole-punch the tops of the trees and thread with ribbon or yarn if desired.



BUTTON WREATH PICTURE ORNAMENT

Materials Needed:

- Scissors
- Glue • Tape
- Ribbon Construction paper
 - Photograph

Buttons Instructions:

Cut a photograph into a circular shape. Glue photograph to a piece of construction paper. Glue buttons around the edges of the photograph. Cut out a circle around the buttons. Make a bow out of ribbon and glue to the bottom of the ornament. Make a hanging loop out of ribbon and tape to the back of the ornament.

SALT DOUGH HANDPRINT ORNAMENT

Materials Needed:

Dough Ingredients:

- Ribbon
- 2 cups plain flour • ¹/₂ cup salt
- Permanent marker • ¹/₂ cup water
- Varnish
- Paint
- Butter knife
- Straw or pencil

Instructions:

Mix the dough ingredients in a large bowl. Roll out to about 1/4 inch thickness.

Cut a circular shape out of the dough with butter knife.

Using a straw or pencil, poke a hole in the top of the dough.

Have your child place a hand in the dough pressing down firmly with each finger to create the imprint pattern. Allow dough to dry approximately 12 hours (thicker ornaments may take longer).

Paint the ornament any color you choose. Once the paint dries write the child's

name and age or current year on the ornament.

Spray with varnish. Thread a ribbon through the hole at the top and tie a knot to form a hanging loop.
